Docklands thumbs its nose at **the gloom**

Despite press reports of financial doom and gloom, Docklands is powering ahead.

The national press has reported some scaling back or postponements at Bourke Junction and Village Docklands.

But VicUrban general manager, Docklands and Major Projects, Michael Hynes, said: "Development across Docklands remains strong, as the majority of the sites are contracted for development and a number of projects are under construction."

"The global economic situation has raised some challenges for the delivery of major projects. However Docklands is a long-term, market-driven development and, as such, changes in the economic cycle are expected and factored into its development timeframe."

According to MAB's project director for NewQuay, Richard Marshall, MAB was feeling very positive about its recently-announced Harbour 1 development.

"There is a shortfall of apartments in Melbourne. You can't get enough stock," he said.

"The fundamental demand for housing is not being fulfilled, especially for one and two bedroom apartments, and H1 is designed to provide value for money in both price and amenity."

Mr Marshall added that although the project was not to be officially launched until next year, the feedback so far had been very good and he anticipated that there would be no issues with financing.

"We have an advantage. As a private company, we have very good banking relationships and, given our standing, are reasonably comfortable that we stack up well," he said.

Pan Urban managing director Danny Ciarna was just as up-beat and said that its \$300 million north east stadium precinct development Lacrosse had been "underpinned by strong sales of individual apartments".

"Our project is almost 100 per cent sold. The current crises hasn't really caused the project to slow. It's progressing well. We've just finalised a builder ... we are moving

forward, but these things take time in any environment. It may take a little longer, but right now we start building at Easter and our completion date is still 2011."

Lend Lease has confirmed that its various Victoria Harbour projects are continuing. These pre-committed projects include ANZ, Myer, The Montage and the Children's Hub above Safeway.

Lend Lease Development general manager — business development, Maurice Cococchia, said: "We have also recently commenced development of The Merchant residential project and have just launched a new residential tower, Convesso Concavo to be located next to Dock 5."

"Whilst the global financial crisis has affected the Australian market, Victoria Harbour is continuing to proceed in accordance with our overall development strategy," he said.

"Development across Docklands remains strong, as the majority of the sites are contracted for development and a number of projects are under construction."

Mirvac CEO Greg Collins was also positive about moving forward in Docklands: "In the lead up to summer we are continuing to see steady interest in our marina berths at Marina YE and we are looking forward to the launch of what will be an unrivalled apartment building mid-next year."

And local real estate agent Glen Lucas has reported eight sales individually valued at \$1m+ since September, comprising 40 per cent of total sales for the period. Lucas Real Estate considers recent results as being indicative of an improvement in the top end of the Docklands property market, with overall sales equalling those recorded over the same period last year, in what was considered the peak of the market.

In a property market that is reportedly all doom and gloom, it seems that Docklands, previously viewed by many as the problem child of inner city residential real estate, is still performing well, both at the top and bottom end of the price range.

The trike is Australian-made, features Harley Davidson parts and is powered by a 1916cc Volkswagen engine.

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Divisions on liquor licensing bid

Docklands is divided over the issue of late night entertainment.

On one side are businesses which want to continue to promote Docklands as an entertainment precinct. And on the other side are some residents who say enough is enough and the area can't cope with any more revellers.

The issue has come to a head around an application for a general 1am liquor licence by the new Woolshed Pub at Central Pier.

Objections to the licence application were heard by a panel of Liquor Licensing Victoria on October 29 and, at the time of publication, the Director of Liquor Licensing was yet to announce an outcome.

The Woolshed Pub had hoped to be trading by now and does not know if, or when, it will be able to do so.



General Manager Duncan Laidlaw (pictured left) said there was a misconception that the pub would attract large numbers of unruly patrons.

"Nothing could be further from the truth," he said. "We are a fine dining establishment with seating for 100 people upstairs and about 150 downstairs."

He said there was another part of the establishment which would be able to host pre-dinner drinks for up to 800 people attending functions at the adjacent Shed 14.

But critics of the pub say an application for a licence for up to 1445 people is just too many.

Acting Snr Sgt Daryl Thompson said the Victoria Police opposed the application because there was already a heavy concentration of licences at Central Pier and the amenity of the area would suffer if there were 1445 more people.

The police objection cited a likelihood of "noise issues, property damage, assaults, drunkenness and unruly and unsociable behaviour".

He said police were unlikely to oppose an application for a restaurant licence for far fewer patrons.

The Dock 5 resident objector Peter Henderson (pictured right) said his main concern was with noise from outdoor areas which travels more readily over open water.

He said it was almost impossible to reverse a licence once it was issued and he feared what would happen at the venue in the future if a general licence was granted for 1445 people.

"The problem is they say they are going to trade differently to what they have applied for. The time to get it right is at the time of applying for a licence," he said.

He said it needed to be understood that a general licence would allow the pub



to sell take-away liquor until 1am and Docklands did not have a bylaw controlling public drinking.

"No matter what they say, it may end up as just a beer hall," he said.

The City of Melbourne also objects to the licence on the basis of potential detriment to amenity.

But not all residents are opposed to the licence. NewQuay representative on the Docklands Liquor Licensing Forum, Paul O'Halloran, said he didn't have an issue with the application.

"We feel the people on Central Pier have already demonstrated that they are excellent

at conducting this type of business," he said.

And Docklands Community Association president Michele Anderson said her association no longer had any problem with the application.

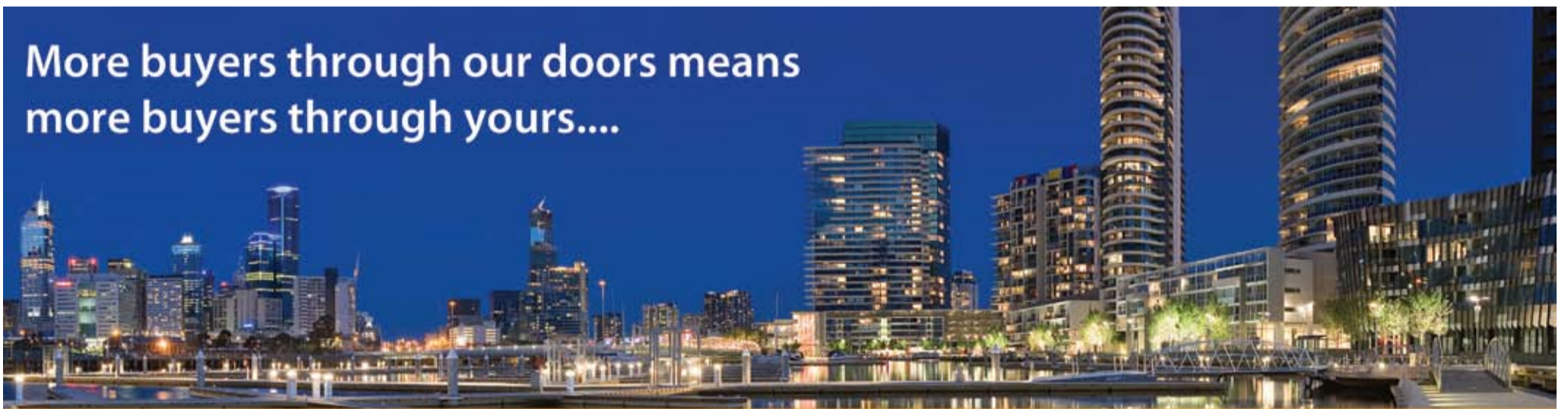

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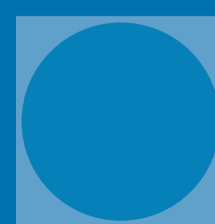
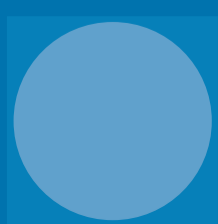
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Docklands says yes to **police station**

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Triumph of the lilies

Photographer David Simmonds submitted this photo of two lilies as part of a fine arts course in the late 1980s. But the folio was failed on the basis that it was not contemporary enough.

Well it seems the picture's time has come because it is now the centre piece and inspiration for an international campaign to market Docklands' latest residential development Convesso Concavo at Victoria Harbour.

Despite failing the course, the image remained a personal favourite of master photographer Simmonds. It's symmetry and beauty inspired the design of his and his wife Sandra's wedding rings.

Some close friends have copies of the image but up until now the photo had not been commercialised.

It's elevation from private favourite to campaign hero started at a lunch conversation with Badjar Ogilvy creative director Chris May earlier this year.

Architects Bates Smart had designed two buildings – one convex, one concave – in a very organic shape which, together, formed one. Mr May spoke of the beauty of living inside and outside. He spoke of flow and connection.

David went away and searched the globe for suitable images which might inspire a starting point for the creative process. He gathered 60 images and then, almost as an after-thought, included one of his own – his photo of the lilies from his "failed" fine art portfolio.

Well Mr May connected with the lilies as soon as he saw them.

"The two lilies echoed everything I was looking for," Mr May said.

In a departure from the usual architectural approach, the agency has based a campaign around the lilies and five other supporting images which David and Sandra conceptualised and produced. The include images of gold fish, feathers, artichokes, Nautilus shells and jade.

David has enjoyed a long and fruitful career as a photographer and is highly regarded, particularly for his architectural work, including some signature pieces early on in the Docklands story.

But he has never before enjoyed success for his still life studies. So the triumph of the lilies is a career highlight.

It was love at first sight for Amanda who saw Rick parking his car in Collins St, City recently.

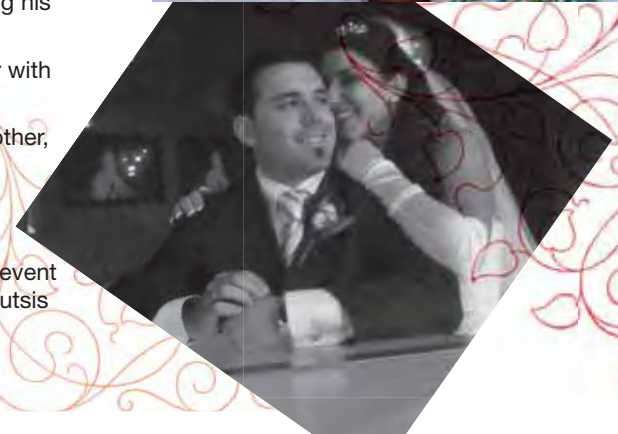
When he got back to his car he found her phone number with a simple message "?"

The Port of Melbourne Corporation is planning a rail link between Webb and Dynon docks but it is feared the proposal will "choke" Docklands' water traffic.

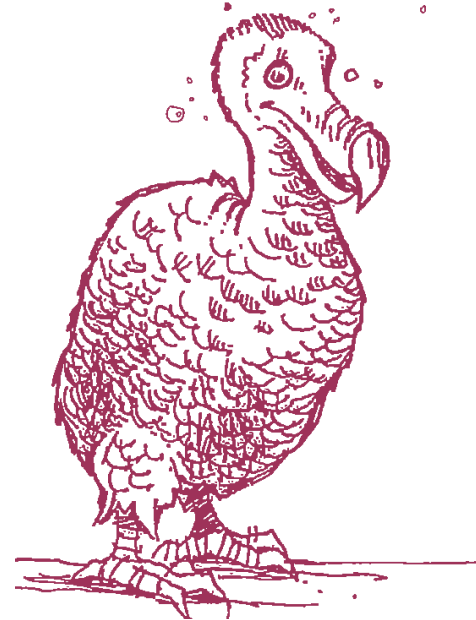
Evoking the analogy of the dodo, the group is warning of extinction unless the Port of Melbourne can be convinced to use a tunnel instead.

Dirty Dottie does Docklands



Marina YE at Yarra's Edge recently played host to Mark Snyder and Dorothy Maggi and their 12.5 metre yacht "Dirty Dottie" from Miami, Florida.

In March, 1998 Mark and Dorothy sold all of their worldly possessions and set sail on their adventure. They cruised the coasts between Florida and Texas for two years, then crossed the Gulf of Mexico, sailing to Mexico, Belize, Honduras and Panama.

They transited the Panama Canal and sailed under the Bridge of the Americas into the Pacific Ocean in January, 2001. From there they sailed the "Coconut Milk Run". That took them to the Galapagos Islands, the Marqueses, the Tuamotus, the Societes, the Cooks, Nuie, Tonga, and then to New Zealand. Leaving from Opuia, NZ, they sailed north to Fiji, then Tuvalu, Kiribati and up the eastern chain of the Marshal Islands.

Returning, they sailed south down the western chain of the Marshals to Vanuatu,

then New Caledonia, and arrived in Bundaberg, Australia with the "Port to Port Rally". They then cruised down the east coast of Australia to Tasmania, where they spent two years circumnavigating Tasmania which Dorothy lists as one of their cruising highpoints.

In their 10 years of cruising they have traveled over 20,000 nautical miles and dropped anchor in the waters of 19 different countries. They swam with humpback whales, sat on the rim of a fiery volcano, danced with restless natives and waited out gales in a mid-ocean reef.

They have seen the "green flash", and enjoyed sun-downers with people from all over the world and from all walks of life. As well they saw a pirate or two and, occasionally, like all sailors, they talked about when they had the wind at their backs.

They sailed into Port Phillip in mid-September to enjoy the big city life for a while and chose Marina YE because it

was so close to Melbourne's city centre and is an easy walk to pick up the free City Circle trams.

In all of their travels Dorothy said: "Marina YE was the only marina they had ever seen, or heard of, that supplied its guests with daily towels and launders them for you to boot."

While here they attended live theatre, dined in many of the different ethnic restaurants and visited as many of the museums, markets, and exhibitions as possible.

They were constantly amazed at the display of public art and the wonderful diversity of the architecture. Dorothy maintained that every person they encountered in Melbourne had been friendly and helpful. Oh, and she did mention shopping.

The crew of Dirty Dottie loved their time with us and thanked Melbourne for extending such a warm welcome.

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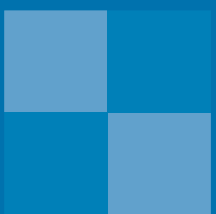
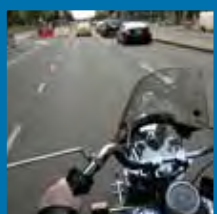
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Merry Christmas Docklands
